

Ride for the Brand Scholarship Application

Ride for the Brand Scholarship – Colorado Technical University Southern Colorado (CTU) is providing an opportunity to assist a qualified potential student with the opportunity to attend a ground campus in Colorado Springs. This scholarship covers tuition only towards a two year associates degree program. The applicant must satisfy the following criteria and requirements to be considered for the Ride for the Brand Scholarship:

- Apply for and be selected by the Ride for the Brand Committee at <http://www.wrca.org/> and the CTU Scholarship Committee.
- Candidates must submit a minimum 500 word typed essay on the American Ranching Heritage due by Sept 1st, 2011.
- The scholarship recipient must be a new potential CTU candidate and must apply and be accepted by Nov 15th, 2011 and start by April 15th, 2012.
- Candidates must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
- Candidates must attend three of the four quarters in an academic year.
- This scholarship expires Mar 15th, 2014.
- All grants or scholarships are applied as a credit to the student's account, and no cash payment will be awarded to the student.
- CTU grants or scholarships are non-transferable and non-substitutable.
- CTU grants or scholarships do not cover books or fees.
- A grant or scholarship may not be combined with any other CTU grant or scholarship.
- When combined with other financial assistance, grants or scholarships cannot exceed the student's cost of attendance.
- Scholarships are awarded based on the availability of funding.
- The grant is not available for the ADN Nursing and Surgical Technology programs.
